Co	CONSTRUCTION EXIT		A CRUSHED STONE PAD LOCATED AT THE CONSTRUCTION SITE EXIT TO PROVIDE A PLACE FOR REMOVING MUD FROM TIRES, THEREBY PROTECTING PUBLIC STREETS.
Cd	CHECK DAM-HAY BALE BARRIER		A SMALL TEMPORARY BARRIER OR DAM CONSTRUCTED ACROSS A SWALE, DRAINAGE DITCH, OR AREA OF CONCENTRATED FLOW.
Dn1	TEMPORARY DOWNDRAIN STRUCTURE		A FLEXIBLE CONDUIT OF HEAVY-DUTY FABRIC OR OTHER MATERIAL, DESIGNED TO OR AREA OF CONCENTRATED FLOW.
Lv	LEVEL SPREADER		A STRUCTURE TO CONVERT CONCENTRATED FLOW OF WATER INTO A LESS EROSION SHEET FLOW. THIS SHOULD BE CONSTRUCTED ONLY ON UNDISTURBED SOILS.
Sd1	SEDIMENT BARRIER		A BARRIER TO PREVENT SEDIMENT FROM LEAVING THE CONSTRUCTION SITE. IT MAY BE SANDBAGS, BALES OF STRAW OR HAY, BRUSH, LOGS & POLES, GRAVEL, OR A SEDIMENT FENCE.
Sd2	INLET SEDIMENT TRAP		AN IMPOUNDING AREA CREATED BY EXCAVATING AROUND A STORM DRAIN OR TOP INLET. THE EXCAVATED AREA WILL BE FILLED AND STABILIZED ON THE COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES.
Sd3	TEMPORARY SEDIMENT BASIN		A BASIN CREATED BY EXCAVATION OR A DAM ACROSS A WATERWAY. THE SURFACE RUNOFF IS TEMPORARILY STORED ALLOWING THE BULK OF THE SEDIMENT TO DROP-OUT.
St	STORM DRAIN OUTLET PROTECTION		A PAVED OR SHORT SECTION OF RIPRAP CHANNEL AT THE OUTLET OF A STORM DRAIN SYSTEM PREVENTING EROSION FROM THE CONCENTRATED RUNOFF.
Ds1	DISTURBED AREA STABILIZATION W/ MULCHING ONLY		ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY PROTECTION FOR DISTURBED AREAS WHERE SEEDINGS MAY NOT HAVE A SUITABLE GROWING SEASON TO PRODUCE AN EROSION RETARDING COVER.
Ds2	DISTURBED AREA STABILIZATION W/ TEMPORARY SEEDING		ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY VEGETATIVE COVER WITH FAST GROWING COVER WITH FAST GROWING SEEDINGS ON DISTURBED AREAS.
Ds3	DISTURBED AREA STABILIZATION W/ PERM. VEGETATION		ESTABLISHING PERMANENT VEGETATIVE COVER SUCH AS TREES, SHRUBS, VINES, GRASSES, SOY, OR LEGUMES ON DISTURBED AREAS.

NOTES:
 1. STORAGE LOCATION AND DISPOSAL PROCEDURES FOR CONCRETE TRUCK OR MIXER WASH OUT. CONCRETE TRUCK WASH OUT LOCATION SHALL BE IN A TEMPORARY TRUCK WASH AREA LOCATED ON THE CREST OF THE ACCESS ROAD. WASH OUT SHALL BE CONTAINED WITHIN A PIT OR TRENCH WITH NO MATERIAL LEAVING THE SITE OR IMPACTING VEGETATED AREAS SHOWN TO BE SAVED ON THE TREE SAVE PLAN. DISPOSAL OF MATERIALS SHALL BE EITHER THE BREAKING OF MATERIAL INTO ACCEPTABLE PIECES AND PLACEMENT WITHIN UNCLASSIFIED FILL AREAS AS DIRECTED BY THE ONSITE GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEER.

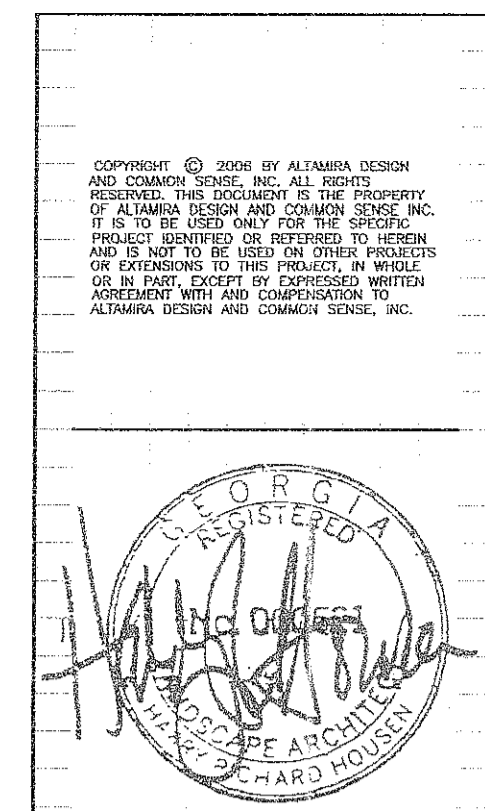
2. EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FOR SPILL OR REPORTABLE QUANTITY OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS SHALL BE STORED AND USED IN AN AREA THAT PROVIDES A SECONDARY CONTAINMENT FEATURE. TYPICALLY THIS WILL CONSIST OF AN EARTHEN BERM CONSTRUCTED AROUND 3 SIDES OF STORAGE AREA. EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FOR SPILLS SHALL BE KEPT IN THE CONSTRUCTION TRAILER INCLUDING EMERGENCY CONTACT NUMBERS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL LOCATE STORAGE FACILITIES IN AREAS WITH THE LEAST FORESEEABLE IMPACT IF A CATASTROPHIC EVENT SHOULD OCCUR.

3. THE NOTICE OF TERMINATION SHALL BE FILED WITH EPD AND DEKALB COUNTY IF APPLICABLE.
 4. I CERTIFY UNDER PENALTY OF LAW THAT THIS PLAN WAS PREPARED AFTER A SITE VISIT TO THE LOCATIONS DESCRIBED HEREIN BY MYSELF OR AUTHORIZED AGENT, UNDER MY DIRECT SUPERVISION.
 5. INSPECTIONS BY A QUALIFIED PERSONNEL PROVIDED BY THE PRIMARY PERMITTEE AND THE ASSOCIATED RECORDS SHALL BE KEPT ON SITE IN COMPLIANCE WITH NPDES PERMIT GAR 100001, 100002, 100003, (2003).

6. THIS IS AN EFFORT TO STOP DISPOSAL OF CONSTRUCTION WASTE (DEBRIS, TRASH, BUILDING MATERIALS, ORGANIC AND INORGANIC MATERIAL) ON DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS AND VACANT PROPERTIES. AS DEFINED IN CHAPTER 14-1, AND COMPLYING WITH CHAPTER 14-57(b) OF THE DEKALB COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING NOTARIZED STATEMENT SHALL BE SIGNED BY THE PROPERTY OWNER OR HIS ASSIGNED REPRESENTATIVE, AND PRESENTED TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL SECTION OF THE DEKALB COUNTY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT AT THE PRE-CONSTRUCTION MEETING OR AT THE ISSUANCE OF A DEVELOPMENT OR BUILDING PERMIT. ENFORCEMENT ON VACANT LOTS SHALL BE AS IF A PERMIT WERE BEING ISSUED. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS POLICY MAY RESULT IN AN ENGINEERING REPORT BEING PREPARED THAT MAY INCLUDE TEST FITS OR BORING OF SUSPECTED SITES.

7. PAINT / CHEMICAL STORAGE, CLEANUP AND DISPOSAL. PAINT AND / OR OTHER CHEMICALS SHALL BE STORED IN SECURED FACILITIES WITH RESTRICTED ACCESS TO EMPLOYEES ONLY. CLEAN UP AND DISPOSAL OF THIS MATERIAL SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL RECOGNIZED LOCAL AND FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS. ALL DISPOSAL SHALL BE APPROVED OFFSITE WASTE FACILITIES CLASSIFIED TO ACCEPT THAT MATERIAL.
