**A RESOLUTION TERMINATING THE MORATORIUM IN THE CITY OF
DUNWOODY UPON ISSUANCE OF BUSINESS LICENSES AND ALCOHOL
LICENESES**

WHEREAS, the City of Dunwoody imposed a Moratorium on December 1, 2008 upon application for, or issuance of, all permits and licenses in the City of Dunwoody, including business licenses and alcohol licenses for a period of sixty (60) days; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find it appropriate to terminate said Moratorium only upon business license and alcohol license applications and issuance, effective December 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Moratorium continues to be imposed on all other permits and license applications and issuances specifically delineated in the original moratorium Resolution 2008-12-21 until the expiration of such Moratorium after sixty (60) days or if terminated earlier by City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dunwoody, Georgia that the Moratorium imposed upon business license and alcohol license applications and issuances by Resolution 2008-12-21 is hereby terminated effective December 31, 2008.
