Authorization for the City Manager to approve Workers Compensation

Insurance for the City of Dunwoody

#### Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the City Manager approve the following Workers Compensation Insurance Quote from Southeastern US Insurance Inc. for the employees of the City of Dunwoody. In addition, in preparation of this information, we have worked with both the President of Bryant Wharton Thompson and Bryant Wharton. They have given personal and very immediate attention. As the City is currently a client with the insurance/retirement packages, it is clear that they are going to provide the same service to us in the workers compensation insurance.

As this is the first year for the City, we are unsure of the experiences we will have. Next year and going forward we will be able to better judge and get even more competitive rates for coverage with private insurance firms. GMA however, will remain the same as all cities are placed together in the same pool and they set the rates.

Based on the information received from the broker, BWT, the quotes, and the references, the HR recommendation is to select SEUS for the worker's compensation policy.

Background:

The City of Dunwoody must establish Workers Compensation Insurance for City of Dunwoody employees.

#### Discussion:

## Process in receiving quotes:

1. GMA who is providing other City insurance was contacted.

- 2. Bryant Wharton Thompson (BWT) who is a branch of Bryant Wharton (the broker for medical & retirement plans) was contacted.
  - a. BWT presented account to Travelers Insurance, Key Risk Insurance and Southeastern US Insurance (SEUS).
    - i. Travelers Insurance does not provide workers comp insurance unless in conjunction with other policies.

- ii. Key Risk Insurance said they received prior submission from another agent/broker and were unable to quote (we don't know who that was).
- iii. SEUS provided quote.
- b. Insurance carriers would not provide quotes to new City as we have no previous claims experience.

### Quote analysis:

- 1. Both GMA and SEUS were provided the exact number of employees and the budgeted payroll per position.
- 2. The quotes and a quote summary is attached to this email.
- 3. Key observations are:
  - a. GMA quotes a rate of 4.94 per police officer and SEUS quotes a rate of 2.90
  - b. GMA puts all cities in a pool and the rate is set for all cities and class codes
  - c. GMA mandates the code that the City Manager is assigned to regardless of the duties of the City Manager (this quote is for someone who is travelling extensively outside of the office, such as a salesperson)

## References (It is my understanding that SEUS is not as well knows as GMA therefore we contacted some references):

- 1. Meriwether County Clerk:
  - a. Fantastic, very thorough, saved \$30k, they will call to make appts-saves time, they had catastrophe in 1st month, very good to work with, will do walk through in bldg to prevent accidents
- 2. City of Auburn Accounting HR:
  - a. Would recommend, very quick, very helpful, will do training, quick to pay claims, will do training, good nurse care

## Financial Impact:

The City would recognize a savings of approximately 70% in a rate premium in selecting SEUS.
