












# Work Orders Completed 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2009 vs. 2010

## PUBLIC WORKS GOALS FOR 2010

- COMPLETE 2010 RESURFACING PROGRAM
- SUBMIT DUNWOODY VILLAGE PKWY CONCEPT TO GDOT
- SUBSTANTIALLY COMPLETE COMPREHENSIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN
- ESTABLISH LEVEL OF SERVICE AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM FOR STORM WATER UTILITY BASED ON THE 40% ASSET INVENTORY

## PUBLIC WORKS GOALS FOR 2010

- DEVELOP SIGN REPLACEMENT PROGRAM
- DEVELOP POLICY TO LIMIT UTILITY CUTS IN NEWLY RESURFACED ROADS
- DEVELOP GIS DATABASES FOR SIGNS, UTILITY PERMITS, ACCIDENTS AND TRAFFIC COUNTS
- IMPLEMENT WORK ORDER SYSTEM THAT IS INTEGRATED WITH GIS AND MOBILE DATA UNITS AND THAT AUTOMATES THE PROCESS FOR CREATING, TRACKING, CLOSING AND REPORTING WORK ORDERS
