
Subject: Peachtree Industrial Boulevard Access Road Naming

In coordination with the Georgia Department of Transportation and the Dunwoody Police Department, the City of Dunwoody has been made aware that the NW Access Road for Peachtree Industrial Boulevard –located within Dunwoody's corporate limits- does not bear an "official" name. This presents a public safety challenge for our Police Department when responding to incidents and accidents. Naming the street will ameliorate potential confusion and improve clarity from a public safety standpoint.

See the attached maps that highlight existing and proposed conditions. Staff proposes naming the road "Peachtree Industrial Access Road."

In officially naming this public street, staff has followed the procedure outlined in Chapter 23, Section 1 of City Code. The item was first heard at a Public Hearing at the regular February Planning Commission meeting. There was no discussion on the item, and the motion carried 7-0. This action before you this evening is being undertaken in conjunction with a City Council Public Hearing, already held on February 22, 2009.

Both the DeKalb County GIS and Planning Departments have been contacted, and the USPS will later be notified through these DeKalb Departments.



## A RESOLUTION NAMING THE NORTHWEST ACCESS ROAD OF PEACHTREE INDUSTRIAL BOULEVARD

WHEREAS: The City has the responsibility to provide for the health, safety and welfare

of the citizens of the City; and

WHEREAS: The proper naming of a street contributes to the health, safety and welfare

of the citizens by making sure that any necessary emergency response is

properly made; and

WHEREAS: The City had identified that the Northwest Access Road of Peachtree

Industrial Boulevard within the limits of the City had not properly been named and thus has initiated the naming procedure pursuant to Article I, Section 1 of Chapter 23 (Streets and Sidewalks) of the City Code of

Ordinances; and

WHEREAS: A public hearing has been held in front of the Planning Commission and

all owners of record who have property fronting on said Northwest Access Road of Peachtree Industrial Boulevard have been properly notified of same, and proper notice of the public hearings has been published in the

City's official legal organ; and

WHEREAS: The Mayor and City Council have held a public hearing pursuant to

Chapter 23 on February 22, 2010 and all proper notifications of said

meeting have been made by the City.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council for the City of Dunwoody that such portion of the Northwest Access Road of Peachtree Industrial Boulevard, running southbound, as is within the geographic limits of the City of Dunwoody shall hereafter be officially named **Peachtree Industrial Boulevard Access Road.**
