

**A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT A NEW MEMBER FOR THE SUSTAINABILITY
COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF DUNWOODY, GEORGIA**

- WHEREAS,** the City of Dunwoody is authorized by the City Charter to create boards, commissions and authorities as the Mayor and City Council deem necessary; and
- WHEREAS,** Resolution 2008-12-31 created the Sustainability Commission for the City of Dunwoody, GA; and
- WHEREAS,** the Sustainability Commission continues to pursue certification by the Atlanta Regional Commission under their Green Communities program; and
- WHEREAS,** Resolution 2009-10-56 established terms for each member of the Sustainability Commission; and
- WHEREAS,** Tracy Coffie was previously appointed as a member of the Sustainability Commission to a two year term, expiring December 10, 2010 and
- WHEREAS,** the position occupied by Tracy Coffie as member of the Sustainability Commission has become vacant, prior to the expiration of the term, and the City Council wishes to fill said vacancy by appointing Sue Ellis as a member of the Sustainability Commission for the remainder of said term.

Sue Ellis, 2 year term..... expiring December 31, 2010

WHEREAS, this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dunwoody while in regular session on August 23, 2010 at 7:00pm, that Sue Ellis is appointed as a member of the Sustainability Commission for the designated terms.
