**A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT A NEW MEMBER FOR THE SUSTAINABILITY
COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF DUNWOODY, GEORGIA**

WHEREAS, the City of Dunwoody is authorized by the City Charter to create boards, commissions and authorities as the Mayor and City Council deem necessary; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2008-12-31 created the Sustainability Commission for the City of Dunwoody, GA; and

WHEREAS, the Sustainability Commission continues to pursue certification by the Atlanta Regional Commission under their Green Communities program; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2009-10-56 established terms for each member of the Sustainability Commission; and

WHEREAS, Yvonne Williams was previously appointed as a member of the Sustainability Commission to a three year term, expiring December 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the position occupied by Yvonne Williams as member of the Sustainability Commission will become vacant at the expiration of the term, and the City Council wishes to fill said vacancy by appointing Kate Sloane as a member of the Sustainability Commission with the following term:

Kate Sloane, 3 year term..... expiring December 31, 2014

WHEREAS, this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dunwoody while in regular session on December 12, 2011 at 7:00 pm, that Kate Sloane is appointed as a member of the Sustainability Commission for the designated term.
