- WHEREAS,** the first "Clean, Fix and Shine-Up Dunwoody Day" was held on March 14, 2009 in coordination with the Dunwoody Volunteer Coordination Committee and volunteers from the North Atlanta Church of Christ; and
- WHEREAS,** volunteers turned out on a cold, rainy Saturday to support and give back to their community by picking up trash, painting and making repairs to structures; and
- WHEREAS,** Dunwoody United Methodist Church held their own "Great Day of Service" on October 16, 2010, with a number of volunteers participating in a clean-up of Dunwoody Nature Center; and
- WHEREAS,** on November 6, 2010, the second annual "Clean, Fix and Shine-Up Dunwoody Day" was held in coordination with the Dunwoody Volunteer Coordination Committee, North Atlanta Church of Christ, Dunwoody Baptist Church, All Saints Knights of Columbus, Life Center Church, Rivers Alive and Dunwoody Student Volunteer Organization; and
