

## PROCLAMATION

Whereas, Dan Weber was elected in 2004 to represent the voters in the 40<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District in the Georgia legislature,

And whereas, Dan Weber convened the first public meeting on establishing a new city of Dunwoody in December, 2005,

And whereas, Dan Weber introduced Senate Bill-58 in the legislative session in the Spring of 2006,

And whereas, Dan Weber established and served on the board of the Citizens for Dunwoody, a non-profit organization to gather information on the feasibility of cityhood and to educate Dunwoody residents on the issues surrounding incorporation,

And whereas, Dan Weber spearheaded the fundraising efforts to raise the \$40,000 needed to fund the feasibility studies for incorporation,

And whereas, Dan Weber championed Dunwoody incorporation in the 2006, 2007 and 2008, legislative sessions,

And whereas, Dan Weber was ultimately successful in passing Senate Bill-82 which gave the voters of Dunwoody the right to vote on incorporation,

And whereas, Dan Weber was a leading advocate for cityhood in the weeks and months leading up to the incorporation referendum,

And whereas, Dan Weber was instrumental in developing an alternative approach to contracting which ultimately led to our multi-vendor solution for city services,

And whereas, Dan Weber also championed and succeeded in working for passage in the Senate of House Bill-264 which ensured the turnover of park land to Dunwoody and granted Dunwoody its fair share of HOST funds,

And whereas, Dan Weber has represented the 40<sup>th</sup> District with honor and distinction for the last six years,
