John,

Because we did not report a full year of crime in 2009, the FBI did not publish our crime stats. As a result, this group made an estimate. In looking at the article itself, it looks like they only refer to using the county numbers for job growth, not crime stats. They also messed up on the population. Our 2010 crimes stats are available now from the FBI.

I looked at our numbers for 2010 and here is where we are at:

Crime Against Persons: 2.25 crimes per 1,000 Crimes Against Property: 36.53 crimes per 1,000

I pulled a few surrounding cities and calculated their rates as compared to ours. Here they are:

In 2010, the Dunwoody Police Department had almost 20% more Part 1 Crime than the Alpharetta Police Department. The Alpharetta Police Department has 130% more officers than the Dunwoody Police Department.
