**A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT NEW MEMBERS FOR THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL FOR
THE CITY OF DUNWOODY, GEORGIA**

WHEREAS, the City of Dunwoody is authorized by the City Charter to create boards, commissions and authorities as the Mayor and City Council deem necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council previously adopted Chapter 27 ("City of Dunwoody Zoning Ordinance") of the City Code of Ordinances which calls for the creation of the Community Council; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2009-01-10 created the Community Council for the City of Dunwoody, GA; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2009-01-10 established terms for each member of the Community Council; and

WHEREAS, Robin Burch, Brian Cosgrove, Dennis Crean, Austin Kearney, and Page Olson were previously appointed as members of the Community Council to a three year term, expiring January 26, 2012 and

WHEREAS, the positions occupied by Robin Burch, Brian Cosgrove, Dennis Crean, Austin Kearney, and Page Olson as member of the Community Council have become vacant as of January 26, 2012, and the City Council wishes to fill said vacancies by appointing the following seven (7) persons to the Community Council for the City of Dunwoody, and at the following terms of office for each member:

- Clayton Coley, 3 year termexpiring January 26, 2015**
- Tony Delmichi, 3 year termexpiring January 26, 2015**
- Rick Callihan, 2 year termexpiring January 26, 2014**
- Norb Leahy, 2 year termexpiring January 26, 2014**
- Stephan Barton, 1 year termexpiring January 26, 2013**
- Susan Harper, 1 year termexpiring January 26, 2013**

WHEREAS, this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dunwoody while in regular session on February 27, 2012 at 7:00 pm, that the persons herein named are appointed as members of the City of Dunwoody Community Council for the designated terms.
