Subject: **Approval of Contract for Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant**

ITEM DESCRIPTION

Approval of a contract with the Georgia Department of Transportation to receive up to \$228,931.53 for road resurfacing through the Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG) program.

BACKGROUND

The City has requested and received a Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG) for road resurfacing from the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT). Funding for the LMIG program is determined each year by the Georgia General Assembly using revenue from the state motor fuel tax. The total funding is proportioned among cities and counties based on population and road mileage. The amount designated for Dunwoody in 2011 is \$228,931.53.

The agreement provides for reimbursement to the City on a unit price for paving cost basis up to the grant award amount.

Paving can commence once the GDOT contract is executed and notice to proceed is received from the State.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends approval of the standard LMIG contract with GDOT contingent upon final legal review so that the City is eligible to receive the reimbursement for paving of the streets listed above.
