Subject: **Resolution to Adopt GIS Bulk Data Fees**

ITEM DESCRIPTION

The item before you tonight is a resolution to formally adopt GIS bulk data fees.

BACKGROUND

On February 27, 2012, Mayor and Council reviewed a proposal to adopt GIS bulk data fees for private firms seeking data for their own personal use.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends adopting the aforementioned fees by resolution.

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND APPROVING GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION
SYSTEM (GIS) BULK DATA FEES**

WHEREAS, the City of Dunwoody has developed a robust GIS database to support its operations and management, including maintenance of aerial photos, parcels, street centerlines, hydrology, zoning and storm water information; and

WHEREAS, the City routinely shares GIS information with entities the City is conducting business with pursuant to a Data License Agreement, including ChatComm 911 for emergency dispatch and Urban Collage for Master Plan renderings; and

WHEREAS, private firms also desire to have access to the GIS bulk data and the City desires to allow such access to the City’s GIS system, pursuant to a Licensing Agreement as well as O.C.G.A. §50-29-2, authorizing reasonable compensation to the City for providing said proprietary information.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council for the City of Dunwoody, while in session on March 26, 2012, that the following Fees for use of the City’s GIS bulk data are hereby adopted:

- (a) A package that includes City Boundary, Subdivisions, Tax Parcels, Zoning and Street Center Lines information: \$600/package.
- (b) Aerial photos: \$100/tile.
- (c) Topography: \$25/tile.
- (d) Stormwater information: \$100.
