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**ITEM DESCRIPTION**

Demonstration of the Geographic Information System (GIS) interactive Map and Data Viewer.

**BACKGROUND**

Over the past three years, the City of Dunwoody has developed robust GIS databases to support its operations and management through the spatial analysis of data. The City's Community Development Department currently maintains more than fifty GIS layers including aerial photos, parcels, street centerlines, hydrology, zoning, and stormwater information to name a few.
