Subject: May 8th - Dunwoody Councilmember Adrian Bonser - Exec Sesion Violation?

Gentlemen,

The Dunwoody City Council met this evening and I wanted to bring to your attention a public accusation against the City of Dunwoody made by Dunwoody Councilmember Adrian Bonser that she met with the two you on May 8th and that you informed her that our closed executive sessions regarding the intertwined purchase and sale of real estate into one transaction violated the open records act.

My memory serves that Council asked this question and that the City (Brian Anderson, Warren Hutmacher, Lenny Felgin) reached out to Mr. Ritter who said we were fine to act as we intended.

We have had several council meetings since Dr. Bonser's May 8th meeting with you and this is now the first that we are hearing of this.

I welcome your comments as to the accusations and any analysis that you may have provided the City of Dunwoody regarding an intertwined real estate purchase/sale and its suitability for exec session.
