**Subject:** **Discussion of Contract for Full Depth Reclamation and Paving of the Dunwoody Senior Baseball Parking Lot**

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**BACKGROUND**

The City Council allocated \$100,000 in the 2014 budget for parking lot resurfacing at Dunwoody Park. An evaluation of the pavement at the park indicated that full depth reclamation would be the best resurfacing method based on the extensive cracking and minimal pavement thickness that currently exists. Full depth reclamation is a process whereby the existing pavement is completely pulverized and mixed with the underlying soil. Cement is added to the soil-aggregate mixture to form a stabilized base which is overlain with new asphalt pavement.

On July 9<sup>th</sup>, the city received the following bids for full depth reclamation and paving of the Dunwoody Senior baseball parking lot:

<b>1.</b>	<b>Stewart Brothers</b>	\$151,456.25
<b>2.</b>	<b>Blount Construction</b>	\$156,062.50
<b>3.</b>	<b>Sunbelt Asphalts</b>	\$164,931.25

**RECOMMENDED ACTION**

Staff is currently reviewing the bids and evaluating alternatives to lower costs. A final recommendation will be presented at the July 28<sup>th</sup> City Council Meeting.
