Playground

ITEM DESCRIPTION

The RFP Review Team recommends awarding Contract 2015-02 For Purchase and Installation of Playground Equipment at Dunwoody Park to Hasley Recreation Incorporated

BACKGROUND

The City solicited proposals from qualified consultants to provide design and installation services for the replacement of the playground structures at Dunwoody Park. The existing playground structures have reached their lifespan and are in need of replacement. Firms were asked to provide a design to include playground amenities for the 2-5 year old age group and the 5-12 year old age group that fits the natural theme of Dunwoody Park and Nature Center.

EVALUATION

A Request for Proposals was issued in January and the City received 9 proposals. The RFP Review Team, composed of the Parks and Recreation Manager, Public Works Capital Projects Manager, and the Dunwoody Nature Center Director, reviewed the submittals. The combined scores are below:

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Based on insights gained in the proposal process, the RFP Review Team recommends Hasley Recreation Incorporated for this contract because of their significant experience in playground design, approach to the project request and thorough understanding of the desired outcome of the project. A rendering of the proposed playground is attached to this memorandum. Also attached is the individual scoring of the review team, cost for each submittal and a list of the ADA components of the play structure.

FUNDING

The total cost submitted by Hasley Recreation Incorporated for the project was \$225,000. City Council approved \$225,000 as part of the 2015 Capital Project Fund for this project.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff respectfully requests that Council: (1) award Purchasing Contract 2015-02 For Purchase and Installation of Playground Equipment at Dunwoody Park to Hasley Recreation Incorporated in an amount not to exceed \$225,000 (2) authorize staff to provide funding for the contracts; and (3) authorize the City Manager to execute the necessary documents following satisfactory review by legal counsel.
















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
