Subject Hotel Motel Fee Process

Recently the Governor signed HB 564 which provides the City with the authority from the State to increase the existing Hotel Motel Tax from 5% to 8%. The final step in this process is the creation and approval of an Ordinance by the City Council. After careful exam ination and discussion, staff has outlined the following strategic planning process to create the Ordinance and an associated list of projects for Council approval in October.

Draft Plan

C ity staff will identify all eligible projects for funding with the stipulation that only projects included in a previously approved plan will be considered.

Stakeholder Conversations

City staffwill hold conversations with a targeted group of stakeholders to gather information on the inventory of projects and begin to prioritize the projects.

Council Sub€om m ittee

Sim ilar to the annual C ity budget process, the M ayor will appoint three C ouncil M em bers to serve on a C om m ittee to refine and prioritize the project list for final presentation to the full C ouncil.

Public Open House

The City will host a public information open house to share the proposed ordinance and list of projects with residents and community members.

0 rdinance

First read of the final ordinance is scheduled for the O ctober 9th C ouncil M eeting.
