## *• New Fields Are Great*

- East Field opened March 17, West Field opened June 9*
- Thanks to Sandy Springs, Doraville, Chamblee, Brookhaven & the MJCCA for help with fields*
- Rainouts substantially reduced—only when actively raining or lightning vs 2 days lost for rain in the past*
- Field maintenance is different, but easier, less expensive*
- New, modern facilities enhance the experience for players & visitors*
- Positive feedback from all that use the fields*
- Result = Very high demand for field time*

# *Dunwoody Senior Baseball*

- *Goals*

- *Provide positive role models & life experiences via baseball for 13 to 18 year olds from Dunwoody & surrounding areas*
- *Effectively utilize the new facility to subsidize program fees & offset maintenance costs*
- *Create a center of activity to support Dunwoody merchants & Brook Run events (ie Farmers Market, Food Truck Thursdays, etc.)*

# *Dunwoody Senior Baseball*

## • *Programs*

- *Feb to Apr – Middle School League – 38 teams , 4 PCMS teams, inter-league play with 28 more teams*
- *Apr to Jun – Spring Rec Ball – 13-15 & 15-18 year old leagues*
- *Apr to Sep – Adult Baseball, Memorial & Labor Days*
- *Jun to Aug – Summer Wood Bat League – 18 to 29 year olds*
- *Sep to Nov – Fall Rec Ball - 13-15 & 15-18 year old leagues*
- *Aug to Jun – DSB Diablos – Six Dunwoody-based Travel Teams*

# *Dunwoody Senior Baseball*

## *• Tournaments*

- DSB has hosted tournaments for several years*
- Apr to Jun & Sep to Nov – Triple Crown Sports*
  - Friday night, Saturday, Sunday morning*
  - Teams from the Southeast, including DSB Diablos*
  - Average visitors = 500 per weekend*
- Jun to Aug – Perfect Game*
  - Daytime games throughout the week*
  - Teams from the eastern US*
  - Average visitors = 300 per day*

# *Dunwoody Senior Baseball*

## *• Uses of Revenue*

- Subsidize Spring, Summer & Fall Rec Ball programs*
- Provide scholarships for kids that otherwise wouldn't be able to play*
- Perform on-going field maintenance – fill-in rubber crumbs, mound and turf repairs, water hoses, sprinklers, etc.*
- Pay for administrative expenses – executive director & staff, website, internet connection, utilities, insurance, etc.*
- Invest in future improvements such as shade sails, improved netting, completion of bullpens, lockable equipment storage, etc.*

- *DSB contributed to project completion*

• <i>Dugouts upgraded from chain link to cinder block</i>	<i>\$ 14,000</i>
• <i>8' Outfield fence on the West Field</i>	<i>\$ 7,200</i>
• <i>Additional access gates</i>	<i>\$ 7,700</i>
• <i>Batting cage carpeting</i>	<i>\$ 9,900</i>
• <i>Fence caps for netting</i>	<i>\$ 5,200</i>
• <i>Total</i>	<i>\$69,500</i>

<i>• Umpires' lockers</i>	<i>\$ 5,000</i>
<i>• Other</i>	<i>\$ 5,000</i>
<i>• Total</i>	<i>\$225,000</i>
