

**A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT NEW MEMBER FOR THE SUSTAINABILITY
COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF DUNWOODY, GEORGIA**

WHEREAS, the City of Dunwoody is authorized by the City Charter to create boards, commissions and authorities as the Mayor and City Council deem necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Sustainability Committee continues to pursue certification by the Atlanta Regional Commission under their Green Communities program; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2016-03-06 revised the membership of the Sustainability Committee to add two ex-officio members who are high school students who are residents of the City of Dunwoody at the time of appointment and for the duration of the term to serve a 2-year term, and two ex-officio members who are college students who are residents of the City of Dunwoody at the time of appointment and for the duration of the term to serve a 2-year term; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Dunwoody is authorized with confirmation from the City Council to appoint Chloe Beecher as one of two high school students to be appointed as a members of the Sustainability Committee for the City of Dunwoody with the following term of office:

Chloe Beecher, 2 year termexpiring upon high school graduation

WHEREAS, this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
