Using the Phase I development footprint and the master plan information for the remainder of the park property that is outside of the Phase I development area, there is approximately 79.99 acres of urban greenspace. Total property is approximately 102 acres. Therefore, even with the Phase I development and the future improvements per the master plan, the property will have 78.4% urban greenspace once all phases of construction are complete. The Deed restrictions require:

- 1. The Property may be used only for parks and recreation purposes, public education purposes, public cultural purposes, or any combination thereof by DeKalb County, but not assignee of the County.
- 3. No less than seventy percent (70%) of the property shall be used as urban green space.
