Subject: To Declare Items from the Police department as surplus

BACKGROUND

The City has two vehicles from the Police department that staff has now determined that the vehicles to be of no use at our current locations.

The City will sell the vehicles to Pickens County Police Department for a fair market value of \$5,000 each.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

The purpose of this memo is to declare this property surplus and authorize the City Manager to dispose of it in a cost effective manner.

A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE PROPERTY SURPLUS; TO PROVIDE A MECHANISM FOR THE SALE AND DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Dunwoody is authorized to declare property owned by the City as surplus when said property is deemed to be of no further use or value to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have identified the items brought forth by the Police Department to be of no further use to the City and wishes for said to be disposed as provided for by Georgia law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUNWOODY, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and City Council hereby determine the aforementioned property, to be of no further use to the City and, therefore, declares said property to be surplus, suitable for disposal as directed by Georgia Law.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager or designee to negotiate the disposal of the property with a preference for it to still be used for a public purpose; however, that does not preclude other methods of disposal.
