The City has two vehicles in the Police department (VIN# 1GNLC2EC5FR2677102 with mileage at 121,528 and VIN# IGNLC2E01DR207529 with mileage at 113,692); staff has now determined the vehicles have no future use in our current operations.

The City will sell the vehicles to the Pickens County Sheriff's Office for a fair market value of \$20,000.
