**Subject:** To Declare Vehicle from the Police department as surplus

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### **BACKGROUND**

The City has a vehicle in the Police department (VIN# 1GNLC2E01DR206753) that staff has now determined that the vehicle has no future use in our current operations.

The City will sell the vehicle to the Pickens County Sheriff's Office for a fair market value of \$5,000.

### **RECOMMENDED ACTION**

The purpose of this item is to declare this property surplus and authorize the City Manager to dispose of it in a cost effective manner.

**A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE PROPERTY SURPLUS; TO PROVIDE A MECHANISM FOR THE SALE AND DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS,** the City of Dunwoody is authorized to declare property owned by the City as surplus when said property is deemed to be of no further use or value to the City; and

**WHEREAS,** the Mayor and City Council have identified the item brought forth by the Police Department to be of no further use to the City and wishes for said to be disposed as provided for by Georgia law.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUNWOODY, as follows:**

**Section 1.** That the Mayor and City Council hereby determine the aforementioned property, to be of no further use to the City and, therefore, declares said property to be surplus, suitable for disposal as directed by Georgia Law.

**Section 2.** That the Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager or designee to sell the vehicle to Pickens County Sheriff’s Office.
