Proposal Bond Requirements

001-009 Each contractor must state in writing the actual dollar amount included on their Bid Bond; simply stating "5% of

the base bid price" is not acceptable.

The DCSS Bid Bond Form must be used. The AIA Bid Bond Form is not acceptable.

Selection Process

001-010 This is a design/build project, therefore all proposals will be reviewed based on the criteria noted in the RFP.

There will not be a public bid opening.

DCSS does not anticipate the need for interviews, however interviews will be held if the need for clarification arises. All contractors are encouraged to provide as much clarification as necessary in their RFP response.

Each RFP response will be reviewed and ranked by a review panel. A short list and interview process will be developed should the need arise. Pricing will not be opened until all of the proposals have been reviewed. The most advantageous proposer will be recommended to BOE for approval.
