NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND EFFECTIVE by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dunwoody while in regular session on April 25, 2022 at 6:00 pm that Summey Orr is appointed as a member of the Urban Redevelopment Agency of the City of Dunwoody for the designated term.
