#### Action

Approve the master plan for the park located at 5435 Roberts Dr.

#### Summary

The City contracted Pond & Company to develop park master plans through public input meetings and survey data collection. A draft master plan for Roberts Dr. is attached to this memo for Council's consideration.

#### Details

The City began the master planning process for the park property in July 2021. Since that time, staff has held several public meetings and engaged the community through a robust public engagement process. The updated plan was presented to Council at the October 10<sup>th</sup> Council meeting. Based on the direction provided from Council, revisions were made to reflect those requests. The updated draft concept is attached to this memorandum. An opinion of probable cost for construction is also included for Council's consideration.

#### Recommendation

Staff request that Council approve the park master plan for 5435 Roberts Dr.
