

**A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT NEW MEMBERS FOR THE SUSTAINABILITY

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Dunwoody is authorized with confirmation from the City Council to appoint Eli Wesolowski as one of two high school students, and Colin Mey, one of two college students, to be appointed as members of the Sustainability Committee for the City of Dunwoody with the following terms of office:

Colin Mey, 2-year termexpiring upon college graduation
