Subject: Design Contract with KCI Technologies, Inc. for Village Crossroads-

Chamblee Dunwoody Road from Womack Road to Roberts Drive

Corridor Improvements

ACTION

Authorize the Mayor, City Manager, or designee to execute all documents necessary and proper for a design contract with KCI Technologies, Inc. (KCI) for the preliminary engineering of Chamblee Dunwoody between Womack Road and Roberts Drive (Village Crossroads Project)

SUMMARY

The Atlanta Regional Commission has committed \$250,000 for preliminary engineering design of the Village Crossroads. The city currently has allocated \$455,000 in local SPLOST funds for the design phase. KCI has submitted a proposed fee of \$797,001.70 for the 1st phase, which includes concept validation, 30% design phase which will include public engagement, environmental assessments, updated traffic analysis, survey, and utility location. The recommended contract limit of \$837,000 includes a 5% design contingency. Any unused funds from this phase will be applied to the subsequent phases for completion of preliminary design and final design phase. The project will follow the federal requirement for plan development with construction projected for 2028.

The city advertised a Request for Qualifications (RFQ 24-02) to complete the plan development process required for federally funded projects. Five firms submitted qualifications that were responsive to the RFQ and the two firms rated highest for qualifications were asked to submit technical proposals. Based on an evaluation of the qualifications and technical proposals, KCI was rated as the most qualified firm to enter contract negotiations in accordance with the Georgia Department of Transportation's procurement policy.

DETAILS

The Village Crossroads project was identified in the 2011 Dunwoody Village Master Plan. In 2017, the city received federal funding through the Atlanta Regional Commission to develop a conceptual design. The city elected to defer work on the conceptual design until the Village master plan update was completed in 2020.

GDOT approved the concept in October 2023, which consisted of a cycle track and wider sidewalks on both sides of Chamblee Dunwoody Road from Womack Road to Roberts Drive. The cycle track would be separated from the vehicle travel lanes and raised to the level of the




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sidewalk. A landscape buffer with street trees and lighting would separate the cycle track from the sidewalk.




Project Layout






Project Typical Section

Financial Impact

- Project will be a phased contract with the 1st Phase Scope:
 - Survey, Concept Validation, 30% Preliminary Design including Public Engagement, Environmental Resource ID, Updated Traffic Analysis, and Utility Locates.
 - Award Amount: \$797,001.50 + 5% Design Contingency.
- Additional ARC TIP Funding was requested in May 2024.
 - Awards will be announced in August 2024.
