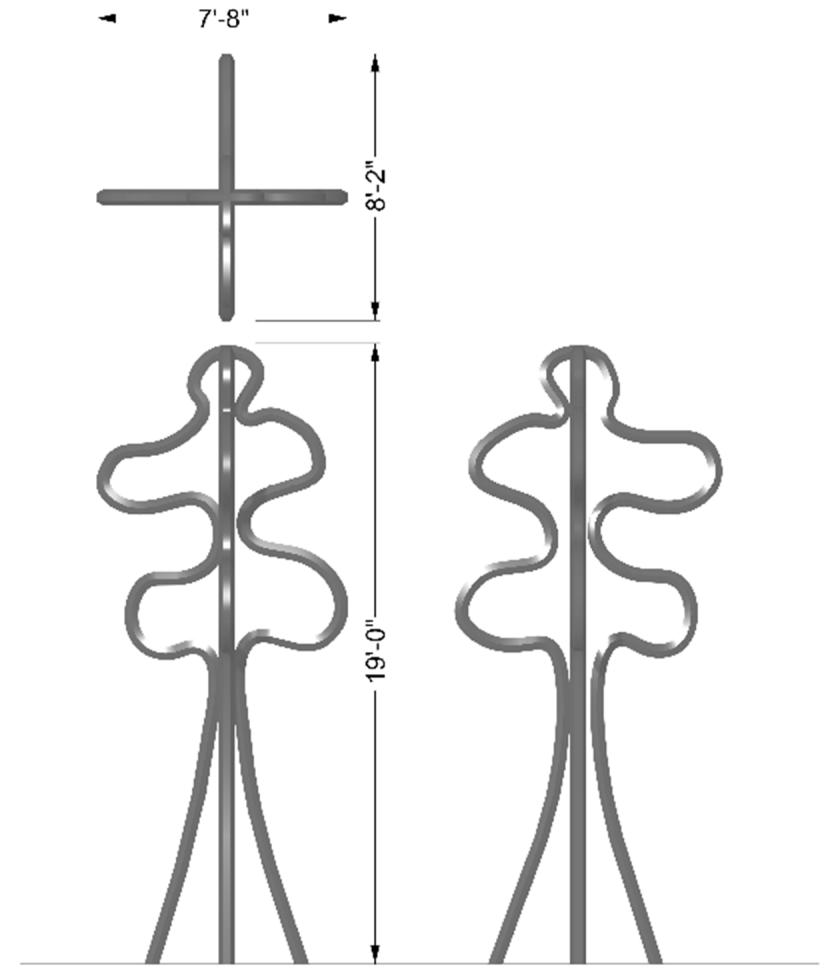
- The Dunwoody Art Commission is proposing the installation of “Human Interfusion,” a large-scale sculpture on Chamblee Dunwoody Road as part of the Georgetown Gateway Project.



Background/Timeline

- 1% of the cost of the Georgetown Gateway Project has been set aside for Public Art which equals \$65,000.
- The Art Commission followed a public request for proposals process which received 28 submissions. A subcommittee selected the top proposal and the Art Commission Approved this selection on September 4, 2024.

Staff Recommendation

- The Struzik ART proposal is \$55,000. Total Budget for the project is \$65,000.
- The Economic Development Department will present a contract with Struzik Art at a future Council Meeting for Council Approval.
