Summary


To authorize the Mayor and City Manager to execute all documents necessary and proper to extend the agreement approved by Mayor and Council on 25 August 2022 between the Dunwoody Nature Center, the City, and the Dunwoody Facilities Authority until 31 December 2025.

Details

In Fall 2022, the Dunwoody Mayor and Council (Council), the Dunwoody Facilities Authority (DFA), and the Dunwoody Nature Center (DNC), entered into an agreement where the City would match the DNC dollar for dollar up to \$1 million for an expansion called the Wildcat Learning Center. That agreement expires 31 December 2024 and the project has undergone delays. This amendment extends that agreement for one year.

Recommendations

Timeline
